- Your thesis should clearly state which side you will support in the argument.
- Your body paragraphs should include specific reasons (at least two) to support your argument as well as detailed evidence from the sources to support your reasons. Your evidence should contain specific examples and you must explain each point. Provide at least two pieces of evidence for each reason.
- Your essay should be typed using a standard (Times New Roman, Calibri) 12 point font.
- Consider all parts of the story and movie when looking for evidence.
- Avoid using "I" ("I think," "I believe"...). State your opinions as facts.
- Your conclusion should sum up your points and leave readers with a final impression.
- All paragraphs should be thorough, specific, and evidence-filled.
